### **Fragile Beginnings**

Of the nearly 800 babies born at Dominican Hospital each year, about 25 percent will need Neonatal care—that's 175–200 babies. The Dominican Hospital Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) is more than a clinical unit in a hospital; it's a first "home" to newborns and a home away from home for parents.
